

Maurice Hilleman - Vaccines List

Scientist Maurice R. Hilleman was involved in the creation or development of dozens of vaccines. He was the first person to combine different viral vaccines into one shot with the MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) vaccine, and the first person to develop a vaccine to prevent a type of cancer in people (hepatitis B vaccine). Dr. Hilleman's work has been credited with saving 8 million lives *every* year. This list notes the vaccines for which Dr. Hilleman played a primary role in the research or development of the vaccine.
